



2026 MATURE COW DISPERSAL

This sale represents the total dispersal of each cow on the inventory in the M,N,P,Q and R drops including Donors. Some older Donors who have been injured are represented by embryo packages, but every cow is represented.

We are also offering the Autumn drop S females with the exception of Ben Nevis Jean S47 who sits at Holbrook Breeders under export obligations. Instead we offer her as an elite embryo package in Lot 3, as well as some exciting PTIC Spring calvers who sit in the calving window of 15 – 30 September.

Over the last five years these cows have faced intense selection pressure and only the best remain. In total there are:

THE GENES ARE IN THE JEANS

FULL SISTERS: LOT 1. BEN NEVIS JEAN N238 & LOT 38 . BEN NEVIS JEAN N119



SELLING FULL SISTERS: BEN NEVIS JEAN H215 X HPCA PROCEED

Lot 1 Ben Nevis Jean N238 sells open and ready to flush and Lot 38 Ben Nevis Jean N119 sells PTIC to Ben Nevis Viceroy V441. These full sisters are daughters of Ben Nevis Jean H215 (82k), maternal sister to Jean M30, full sister to Jean Lot 56 N116, Jean P59 (dam of star donor S47), as well as Ben Nevis Newsflash N239. Newsflash sired the \$72k Ben Nevis Rambo who sired

the \$230k Banquet Tom Cruise and the \$45k Ben Nevis Tribune. Along with sister M30, Jean N238's embryos broke the Angus Australian record at the recent WAF Angus on Ice Frozen genetics Auction selling for \$6,000 per egg to Mackas Angus in 2025. Jean N119's son Ben Nevis Undertaker U63 sold to \$56,000 to Palgrove in our 2024 bulls sale.

LOT 15. BEN NEVIS JEAN P303

Lot 15 Ben Nevis Jean P303 sells with Bull Calf by Ben Nevis Rambo NBNR230. P303, P153 and H215's dams are maternal sisters showing the power and consistency of our cow lines. P303 has been a very successful donor for us and is a prolific egg producer, whose sons consistently feature in our top pens. P303 is the most impressive cow in the flesh showing phenomenal thump consistent with Premier Guardian and the renown Premier Jestress H66 cow in her pedigree. Her eggs raised \$5050 each by Rob and Tania Jarret in 2022 at the Molong Flood Charity Auction and we raised over \$20,000 for flood victims.

LOT 40. BEN NEVIS JEAN Q60

Lot 40 Ben Nevis Jean Q60 'Queenie' PTIC Ben Nevis sells PTIC to Pathfinder Underdog SMP23U752. The Jean family split into two main streams 24 years ago with Donors G124, Lot 4 N17 and H103 on one branch and H215, P303 and P153 on the other. Q60 or Queenie as we affectionately call her is a third generation Donor Dam. Her dam Lot 2 N17 has contributed the most of any other cow in our sale to our herd with 36 progeny including a run of 4 full brothers to Queenie that have averaged \$34,000 at sale and 3 daughters in our current Donor Program including Queenie (Q60), T471 and T480. Queenie is my mum Cherry's favourite cow. She will be flushed pre-sale and weans one of the best heifer calves in the draft.

LOT 3. BEN NEVIS JEAN S47 EMBRYOS

Ben Nevis Jean S47 is our lead Donor going forward and we already know she is up to the task of living up to her royal lineage. Her grand dam is the \$82k Ben Nevis Jean H215 and her dam is a full sister to Lots 1 (previous page) 38 and 55. The Lot 1 sister is the Australian record holder for embryo's sold at auction for \$6,000 per egg to Mackas Angus. We have exported an exclusive package of S47 x Knowla So Right eggs to Darrel and Sara Stevens from Stevenson Down T Ranch in Montana, USA and now we offer the unique opportunity to secure an investment in the very heart of our herd going forward. S47 is currently in export quarantine and will be flushed for 4 x A grade IVF embryos to the bull of your choice.

LOT 4. BEN NEVIS JEAN P153 EMBRYOS

P153's dam is a maternal sister to Ben Nevis Jean H215, and she is the aunt of Lot 15 Ben Nevis Jean P303 (previous page). P153 has sold three sons into studs averaging \$26,000 including her first calf Ben Nevis Ronan to Segenhoe, where he also excelled at the ASPB. Her latest son Ben Nevis Virtuoso was Lot 4 in our 2025 sale and featured in our Grand Champion Pen of bulls at the World Angus Forum. Last year P153 had twins in a very wet and muddy season and had mastitis in her back offside quarter which is why she is not offered physically for sale but as an exclusive embryo package for 4 x A grade IVF embryos to the joining of your choice.

Ben Nevis was built on the Geranium family and most of the modern-day Geranium's stem back to Z61 and E40. Ben Nevis Geranium N39 is a 3rd generation Donor and has had 9 progeny with all of her bull calves going into studs including Ben Nevis Redouble R9 \$30k to Mountain Valley Angus and Ben Nevis Spectre S64 \$38k to Rodger Pryce at Brooklana. Her current bull calf Woodley W673 by Sunstone will be one of the standouts at our upcoming 2026 bull sale.

Celeste Q127 is very special to us and combines the magic of our two highest performing cow families and our two highest performing cows. Q127 is a full sister to the \$72k Ben Nevis Rambo who went on to sire the \$230k Banquet Tom Cruise and the \$45k Ben Nevis Tribune (purchased by Roseleigh and Genetics Australia). Celeste has produced two generations of young Donors in S367 and her daughter U211, plus Donor T264 as well as son Ben Nevis V384 to Hancock Pastoral last year for \$28k. Her current bull calf, Warlord W680 by Tiny Dancer will feature in our 2026 sale.


